Position Details

Purpose of the role

To provide leadership and management of the day-to-day and strategic operations of the Kindergarten (Kindy), including our Before and After Kindy Care Program and Vacation Care.

About the position

This position is located in our Kindergarten on our Stuart Street Campus. The role of Director is to nurture, guide and support our team of professionals to ensure the provision of a high quality Early Childhood Education and Care for our children. The position is responsible for ensuring partnerships with families are developed and maintained, promoting the Kindy so enrolments are strong, monitoring physical environments and facilities, liaising with government and relevant organisations and support the school executive. The ideal applicant will commence in January, 2019.

This is an exciting time to be part of our Kindergarten team and to lead it into the next era of growth as we look to expand by offering flexible class options that meet the changing needs of our community. We have recently become CCS approved and have implemented a new Childcare Management System called Xplor. This role has some financial delegation associated with the operations of the Kindergarten and it is expected that you will effectively manage and maintain our financial indicators, as well as day-to-day staff management.

A core focus of this role is ensure that our Kindergarten meets the standards of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standards as well as ensure adherence to the school and/or Kindergarten policies and procedures. This role will lead and implement a continuous improvement process that reflects our ongoing drive for excellence in our program and performance.

Requirements of the position:

At Westside, we believe that great teachers are the cornerstone to the success of our students. **Applicants who hold an Early Childhood teaching qualification** will be well regarded. However, high performing applicants who have a Diploma of Early Childhood are also welcome to apply.

Other requirements include:

- Experience in leading a Kindergarten Service and making day-to-day management decisions about the operational effectiveness of the Service.
- Ability to work effectively within a team environment
- Ability to adapt to a flexible, diverse working environment
- Experience in Xplor or similar Childcare Management System

- Bachelor of Early Childhood Education (or similar)
- Current registration in Queensland (preferable)
- Senior First Aid (including Asthma and Anaphylaxis management)
- Hold the required Certified Supervisor and Nominated Supervisor Certificates
- A business qualification would be highly regarded
