Position Details

Purpose of the role

To provide quality instruction to Primary students within the College's Protestant, Biblical framework.

About the position

The position is a teaching position within our Primary School to teach Physical Education to children from Prep to Year 6.

The role includes the coordination of the Senior Primary swimming, cross country and athletics carnivals and Junior Primary mini cross country and athletics carnivals. The management of school selections and registrations to all District and Christian Schools carnivals is also a requirement of this role.

Further duties include the coordination of all primary sports teams for district 'gala' days, Christian Schools Team Games and the inter-house sports program. This position is also responsible for liaising with third parties for school-based sporting programs (eg AusKick, Rookies-2-Reds and swimming lessons).

The successful applicant would be supported in their work by the Head of Primary and Head of Junior Primary and will liaise constantly with primary classroom teachers.

This is a contract position for 12 months for the 2019 school year and is based on the College's Primary Campus.

What we are looking for

At Westside, we believe that great teachers are the cornerstone to the success of our students. Applicants must hold a current teaching registration through the Queensland College of Teachers as at the start of the 2019 school year.

Key requirements of this position are:

- Experience in teaching Physical Education to primary-aged children
- Experience in playing and coaching a variety of sports
- Experience in coordinating sports events, including school carnivals and inter-house and/or inter-school sports competitions
- Able to work with a high level of autonomy
- Able to foster enthusiasm in children for Physical Education and a healthy lifestyle
- Highly organised with good attention to detail
- Exceptional communication skills, to not only make suitable arrangements with third party providers but also to work with classroom teachers to rollout a program that is high-quality for staff and students
