Position Details

Purpose of the role

To provide quality instruction to Secondary students within the College's Protestant, Biblical framework.

About the position

This position is a teaching position within our Secondary school and will be assigned a teaching load focussed on delivering Physical Education subjects, including Junior and Senior Health and Physical Education, Sport and Recreation, and preferably Year 9/10 Football Class. The position would also be responsible for the oversight of the College's Secondary Football Program, which is run in conjunction with the Queensland Roar Football Academy.

The successful applicant would work within a team of teachers who specialise in teaching Physical Education and be supported by an Instructional Dean who can give guidance and support regarding the educational outcomes and curriculum delivery required.

This is a permanent position commencing Term 1 2019, based on the College's Secondary Campus.

What we are looking for

At Westside, we believe that great teachers are the cornerstone to the success of our students. Applicants must hold a current teaching registration through the Queensland College of Teachers as at the start of the 2019 school year.

Alongside the teaching and classroom management requirements inherent in a teaching position, other requirements for this position are:

- Experience in teaching Physical Education to secondary students, including at senior level.
- Experience in managing and teaching a high-performance football development program and growing a program to increase student participation is preferred.
- The ability to show initiative and creativity in delivering Physical Education with students ranging from limited experience through to high-performing, in various sporting disciplines.

- The ability to organise and coach sporting teams, particularly Football and Futsal teams.
- A demonstrated knowledge of safety measures necessary to consider when teaching Physical Education
- Be available for and willing to commit to after school sports events
- The ability to foster an interest in Physical Education amongst the student body and grow the number of students involved in regular physical activity.
