- Purpose of the role:** To provide quality musical instrument instruction to students within the College's protestant, Biblical framework.
- Responsibilities:** This position reports to the Instrumental Music Coordinator, with input from the Director of Learning.

About the position

This position provides instrumental music instruction for **piano** to students from Years 4-12. The College operates across two campuses (closely situated) with Prep to Year 6 on one campus (open 8:45am - 2:40pm) and Year 7 to 12 on the other (open 8:30am - 2:50pm).

In 2018, there were approximately 16 students enrolled in piano lessons across the College. Lessons in the Primary school can be in groups of two (30 minute session), however individual lessons with students of any age could be 20, 30 or 45 minute duration. In 2018 the Instructor was able to arrange lessons to fit in one day per week of the school term.

The tutor will **invoice the College** on a weekly basis for all the lessons taught as per their timetable finalised at the start of term. The Instrumental Music Co-ordinator deals with the billing of students for lesson fees through the business office.

The person appointed to the role will be able to choose his/her working days/hours.

This role does not have any supervisory responsibilities for staff or budget.

Requirements for the role

While previous experience working with students in this role is desirable, it is not essential. Either way, you will need to demonstrate an aptitude for teaching students the piano.

Other requirements of this position are;

- Applicants must hold a current 'P' blue card, or apply for this card prior to starting in this role
- Experience playing/teaching piano
- Experience teaching young children in both group and individual lessons
- Confident teaching beginners through to more advanced students (up to Year 12)
- Minimum two teaching references
- Must support the Christian ethos of the College.

The College reserves the right to perform additional qualification, criminal history or other relevant background checks as necessary to this position and you will be notified of any relevant checks if you are offered a position at the College.
